Thank you for your enquiry.

Any student, who wishes to enroll in Charter College, must have passed the previous year at their current school. Most students are required to write an academic assessment exam which covers the basics that they should know in Math's, Science and English. The exam takes approximately one hour. All applications will be subject to a credit worthiness check and academic and behavioural references will be obtained from the child's current school. Students with poor academic and/or disciplinary records will not be accepted at Charter College.

The assessment exams are scheduled on an individual basis, at a mutually convenient time.

We are a Cambridge registered school and follow the Cambridge curriculum. Students write their IGCSE/O-levels in Year 10/11 and complete their AS/A-levels in Years 11 and 12. We *do not* offer a South African NSC (Matric).

The academic standard is challenging, but not beyond an average student who is prepared to work hard. Please note that this is not an "easy Matric" option, the standard of education is high and requires a significant level of academic and personal maturity from the students. Cambridge A/AS levels are accepted by all international and local universities for enrolment purposes. The exams are set, marked and moderated by Cambridge and all qualifications are awarded by them.
